Pretreament and Cleaner Technical Data Sheet

Product Line Prop-prep

Description Prop-prep is a special cleaner and metal conditioner designed remove grease and

other contaminants and provide a chemically conditioned surface prior to painting.

Typical Uses As a pretreatment and cleaner for propellers, shafts, struts and rudders prior to

application of the Propspeed foul release system.

Application: Apply Prop-prep solution liberally by rag or brush, working over small areas at a

time.

Do not allow the Prop-prep solution to dry out. Remove by wiping off thoroughly

with a clean, damp rag.

Wash down with fresh water and dry off thoroughly.

Before applying the Propspeed Etch Primer, solvent wipe complete surface with

Acetone or similar.

Performance and Limitations

Performance

Excellent chemical conditioner that cleans and conditions the metal surface.

Limitations

The surface which has been cleaned with the Prop-prep should be painted as soon as possible after treatment. (Preferably within 4 Hours).

Prop-prep should not be used on zinc, cadmium, and magnesium as these are susceptible to chemical attack by acids.

Health & Safety: Prop-prep is acidic. Operators should wear gloves, goggles and protective clothing.

If splashed onto the skin, wash off with copious amounts of soap and water. If splashed into eyes, wash and flush eye with water for minimum of 15 minutes. In case of ingestion, give patient copious quantities of water or milk. **Do Not** induce

vomiting. In all cases seek medical attention promptly.
